Position Title: **Education Intern, Fall 2017**

Hours and Compensation: MIM will work with interns to create a schedule that fits the needs of both the student and the department. Interns will be compensated at the current minimum wage. Candidates for this internship should be able to fulfill approximately 20 hours per week with some weekend work required.

Purpose and Goals: MIM seeks an intern to work alongside its Education and Public Programs department. The intern will learn how museum education enhances the guest experience while making an important contribution to MIM's mission. The intern will be involved in a variety of activities related to museum education: family program planning and implementation, program evaluation, volunteer scheduling, museum tours, and everyday administrative tasks.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Fall 2017 Museum Guide Training classroom setup and assistance (Tuesdays and Thursdays, October 17–November 16)
- Filling in for drop-in Orientation Tours, as needed, during the busy holiday season for general attendance
- Assist with field trip activities, as needed (greet groups as they come in, set up classrooms, etc.)
- Public Programs assistance (Experience India, September 2–3; Musical Icon: John Lennon, October 7–8; Experience Scandinavia, December 2–3; 'Tis the Season, December 16–17)
- Online MIM Educator Resources updates and edits to MIM.org and any external listings
- Assist with Professional Development for preK-12th grade teachers (October 21, other dates TBA)
- Boy Scout and Girl Scout program assistance (December 16)

Qualifications:

- Completed at least two years of undergraduate work; recent graduates or graduate students may also apply
- Possess strong guest service skills and enjoy working with people (museum guests and internal team members)

- Manage many deadlines at once while keeping an organized, detailed record of progress
- Committed to improving or developing skills in music education (for children ages 0–18)
- Passionate about working with children and families; must be comfortable speaking to groups of adults and children
- Have an interest in education in a museum setting: creating a fun, inclusive, and interactive environment
- Have an interest in the museum’s collections: musical instruments, material culture, and ethnomusicology

Educational Opportunities:

- Gain hands-on experience in informal education, music education, and museums
- Learn and apply museum industry best practices and standards
- Become familiar with non-profit, and specifically museum, organizational practices

Internship Term:

- Fall 2017 with a possible extension for one additional term; 20 hours per week; some weekend work required
